

Instrument Rental – Purchase Scheme

Choose an instrument Rent the instrument for 12 months At the end of the rental you can: -

- Hand the instrument back and have nothing else to pay.
- Hand the instrument back and purchase a new instrument. If you decide to buy a new instrument from Windstruments via your school, the school will claim the vat back for you and once full payment has been received by Windstruments you will receive your 12 rental payments as a full refund.
- Other instruments may be available, please ask.

1st rental of instrument

Before an instrument is supplied we require completed paperwork, payment for the first month, payment for the insurance plus any accessories (eg music books). At the time of processing we will call you to collect the first payment by credit/debit card or you may call into Windstruments and pay the first payment by cash. The insurance is a one off payment of £30.00 to insure the instrument for the rental period. There is a £30.00 excess on the insurance policy. The date of the 1st standing order will be 1 month after the rental start date.

The instrument can either be collected from Windstruments or delivered to the school in time for the first lesson, if the first lesson has already passed, delivery will be made on the first delivery date available after the completed paperwork and payment have been received.

The rental period is for 12 months (this may be extended but not reduced – please telephone the office for further information). At the end of the rental period the instrument can either be left at the school, and Windstruments informed, or it can be returned to Windstruments directly.

If the instrument is not returned by the expiry date further rental payments will be charged. This extra rental will not be refunded if you then buy an instrument. If your rental period finishes during a school holiday the instrument must be made available for collection from the school on the first day of term, if you have not already returned it to Windstruments in person. It is your responsibility to inform us at the office detailed below of any decisions regarding instruments and not the instrumental teachers or the school.
