Colour Run

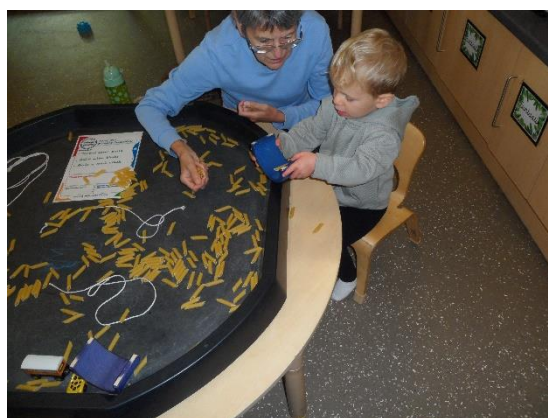
The Colour Run information was sent out via email last week. It is also available on the website at <https://www.sandalprimaryschool.co.uk/whole-school-letters>.






Education drop-in
